Invocation & Mudra Dance




Students of grades III - V glorified the Almighty through a Mudra dance in the Annual Day.

Elements in Dance




The five elements - The Earth, Water, Light, Wind and Space constitute the entire world. Students of grade III conveyed the importance of the five elements through a dance - drama.
