The students of Grade X used infographics as a tool to represent the concepts learnt in real numbers. The presentations were self-explanatory and creative.

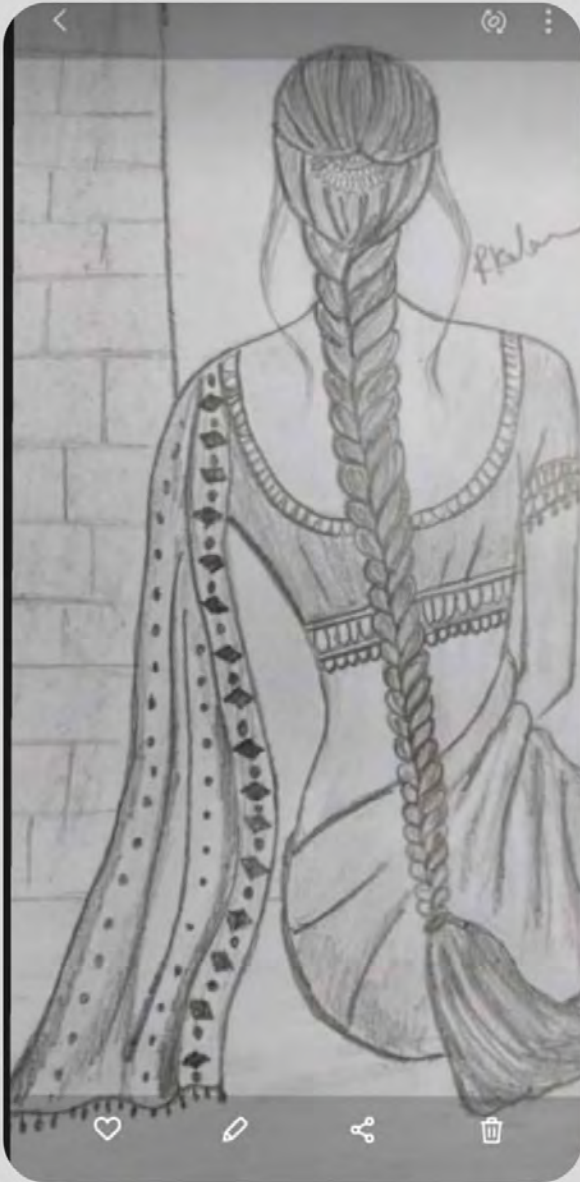
# Movie Session

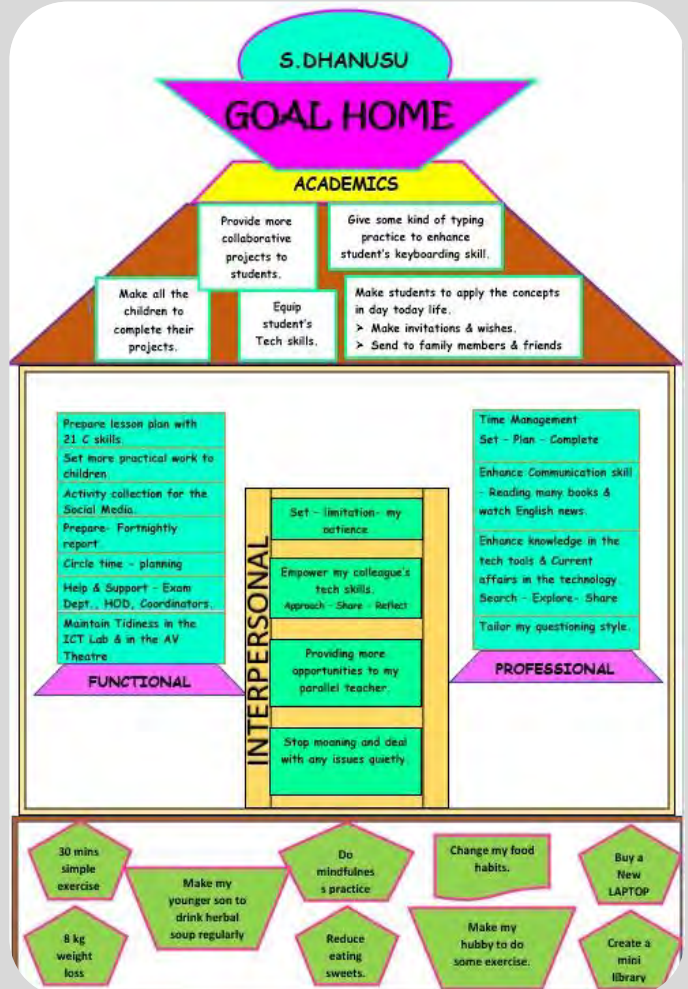
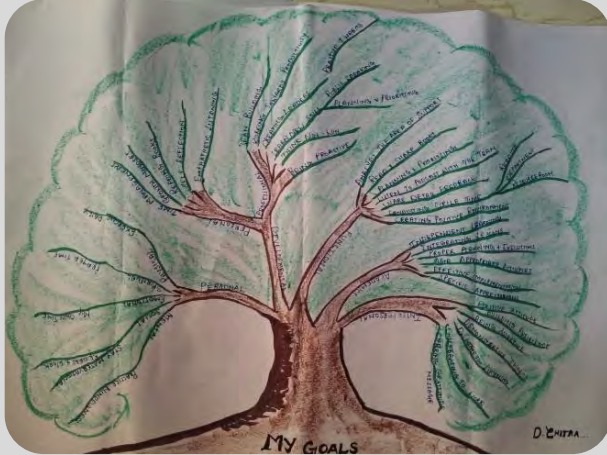

# Features of the Syllabus

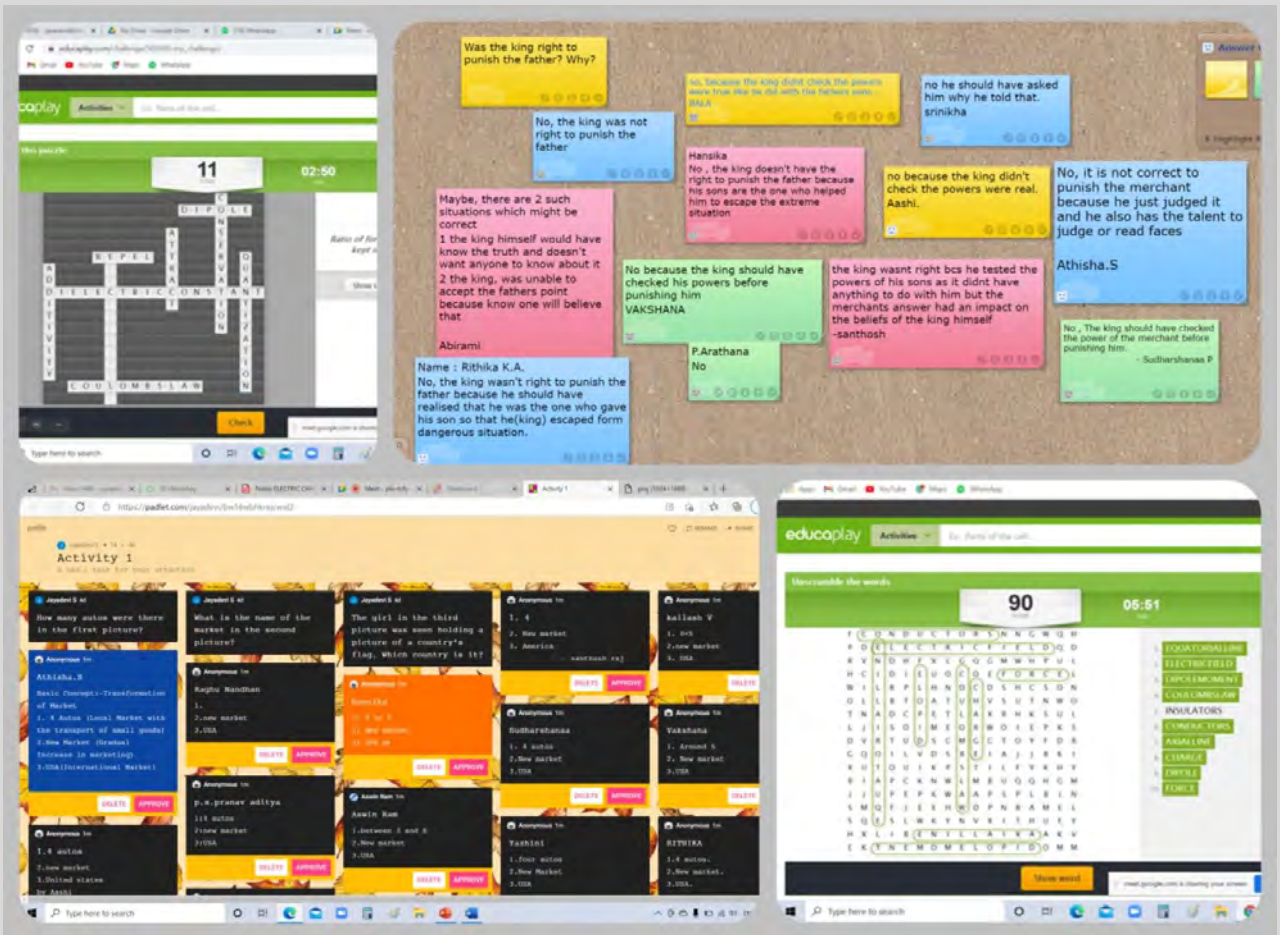


## SALIENT FEATURES OF THE SYLLABUS

- Emphasis on basic conceptual understanding .
- Use of SI units, symbols, nomenclature of physical quantities and formulations as per international standards.
- Promotion of process-skills, problem-solving abilities and applications of Physics concepts.
- Expose the learners to different processes used in Physics-related industrial and technological applications.
- Promote problem solving abilities and creative thinking in learners.
- Develop conceptual competence in the learners and make them realize and appreciate the interface of Physics with other disciplines.

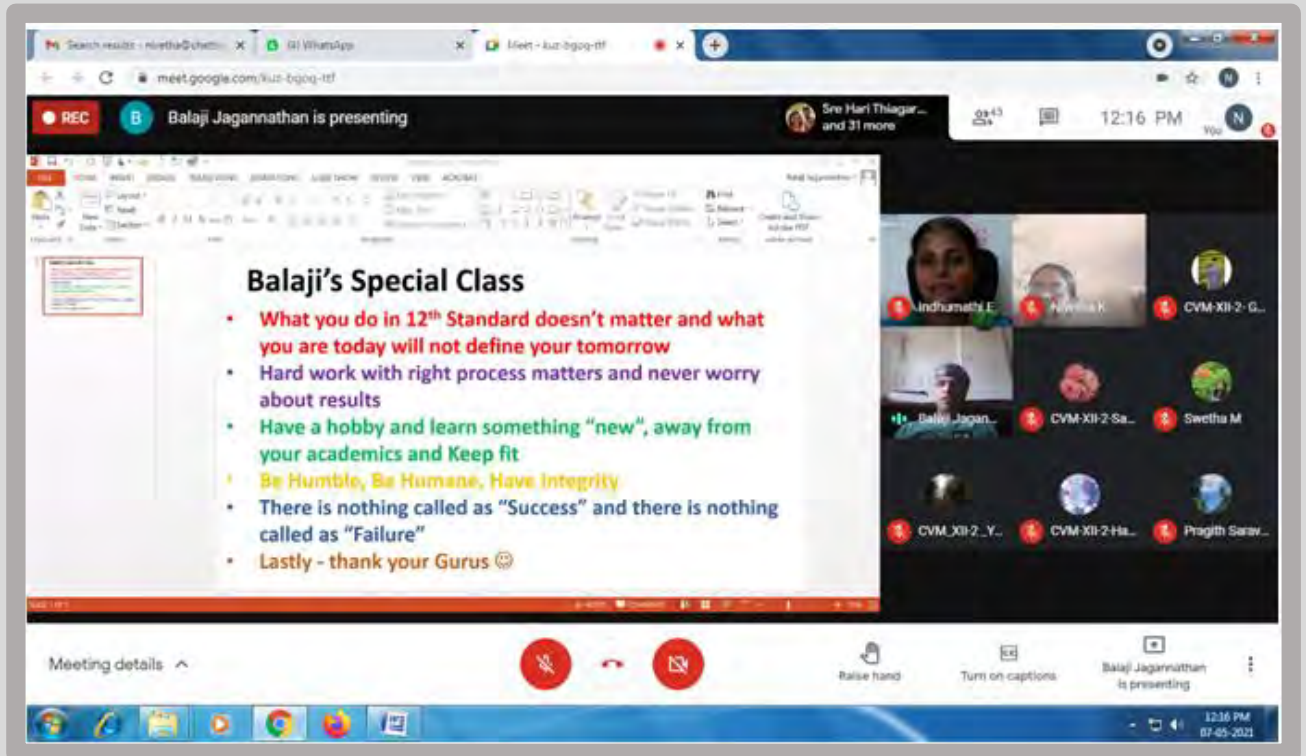
# Wellbeing Activity

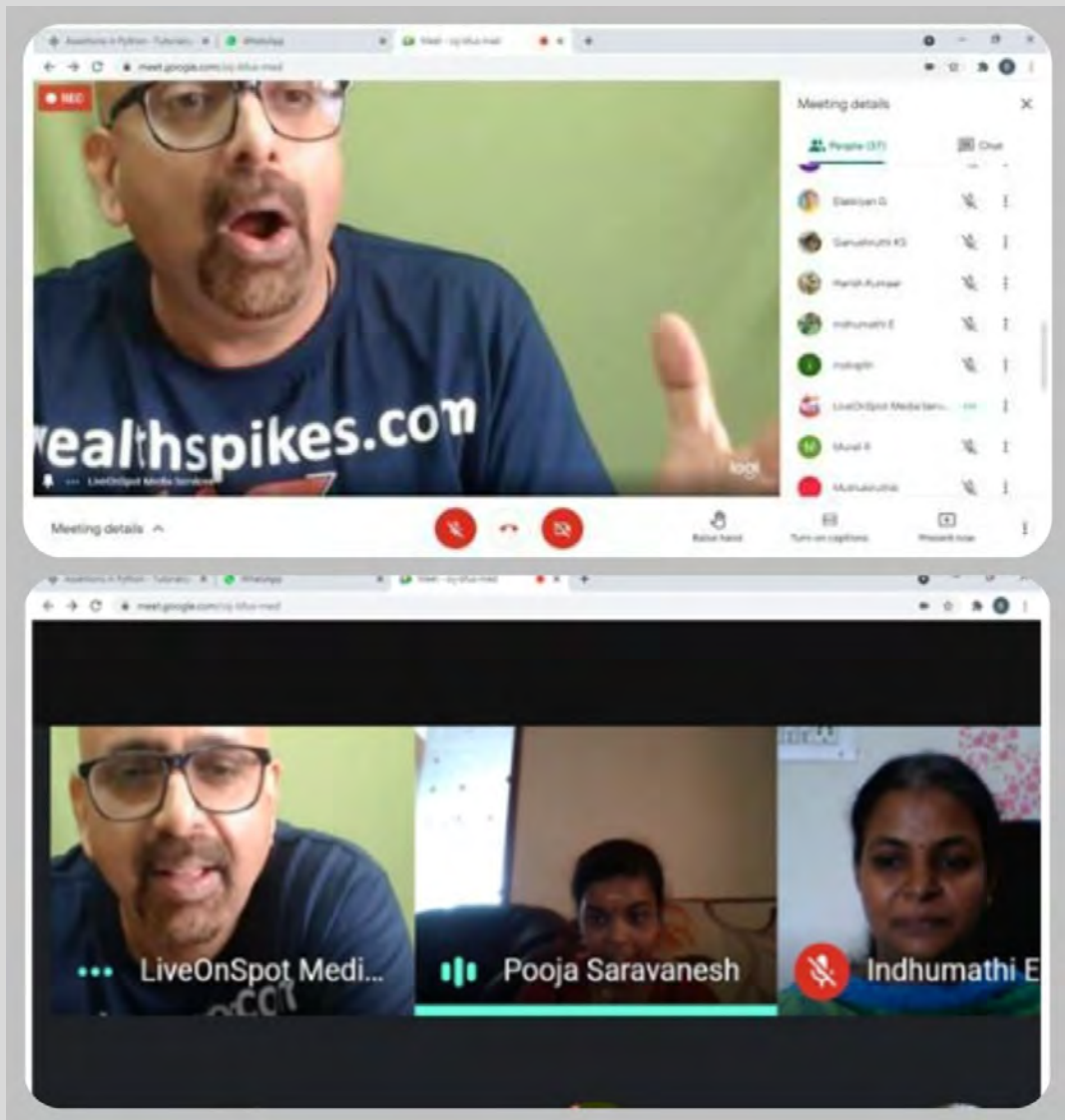


# Video Conference

# Session on Commerce Careers

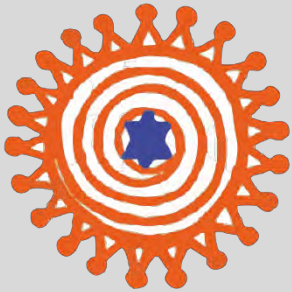
