




# Leader In Me (LIM)





## Google Classroom




A session was conducted by Ms. E. Indhumathi, the H.O.D of the ICT department to equip the teachers to use the Google classroom effectively for assigning various works.

# Wellness Wednesday




Wellness Wednesday is organized in CVM with a variety of exercises regularly planned by the Wellness Committee to ensure physical and mental wellbeing.

## Kalvi Valarchi Naal



## Our Professional Alumni






Pandemic has locked our students inside the houses. Students made their pencils busy. The artworks of our students for your view.

### **Education Overseas**






### Stories

# Model Making





# Save Our Heritage




Grade-V students exhibited their creative thoughts as posters to save our heritage. This activity enabled students to have deep learning about our country's heritage and culture.

## Global Citizenship (GC)





# Mentoring Session





## Model United Nations (MUN)





## An Orientation Programme





## I.I.T Kanpur - A Webinar




