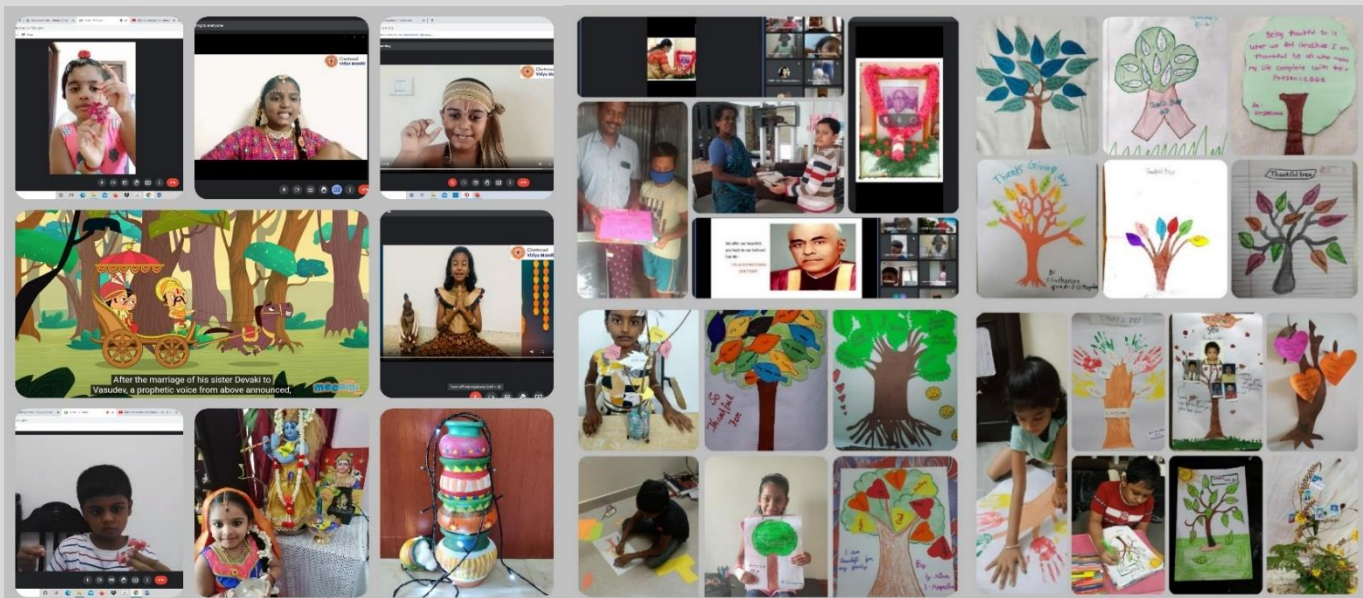

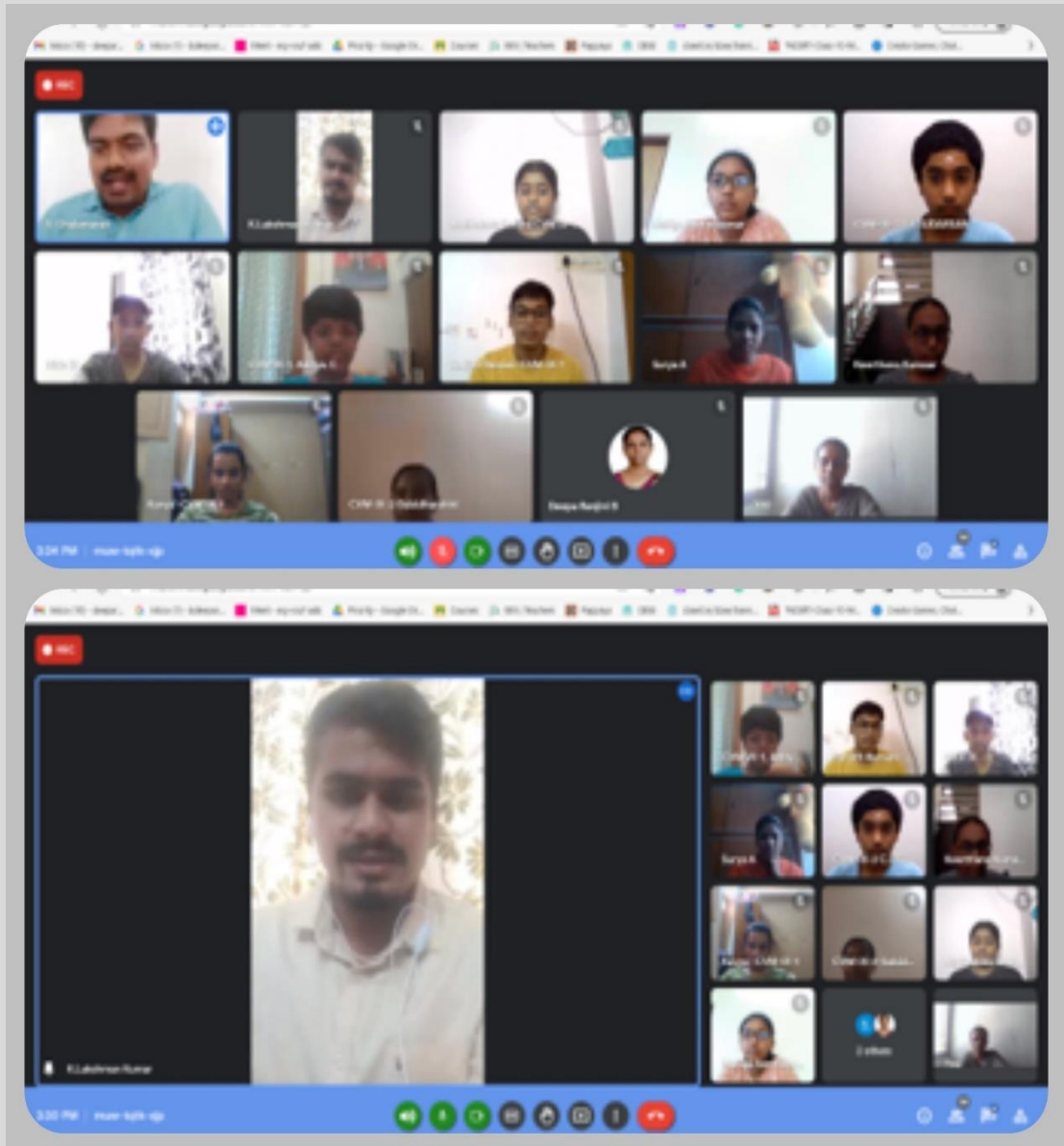

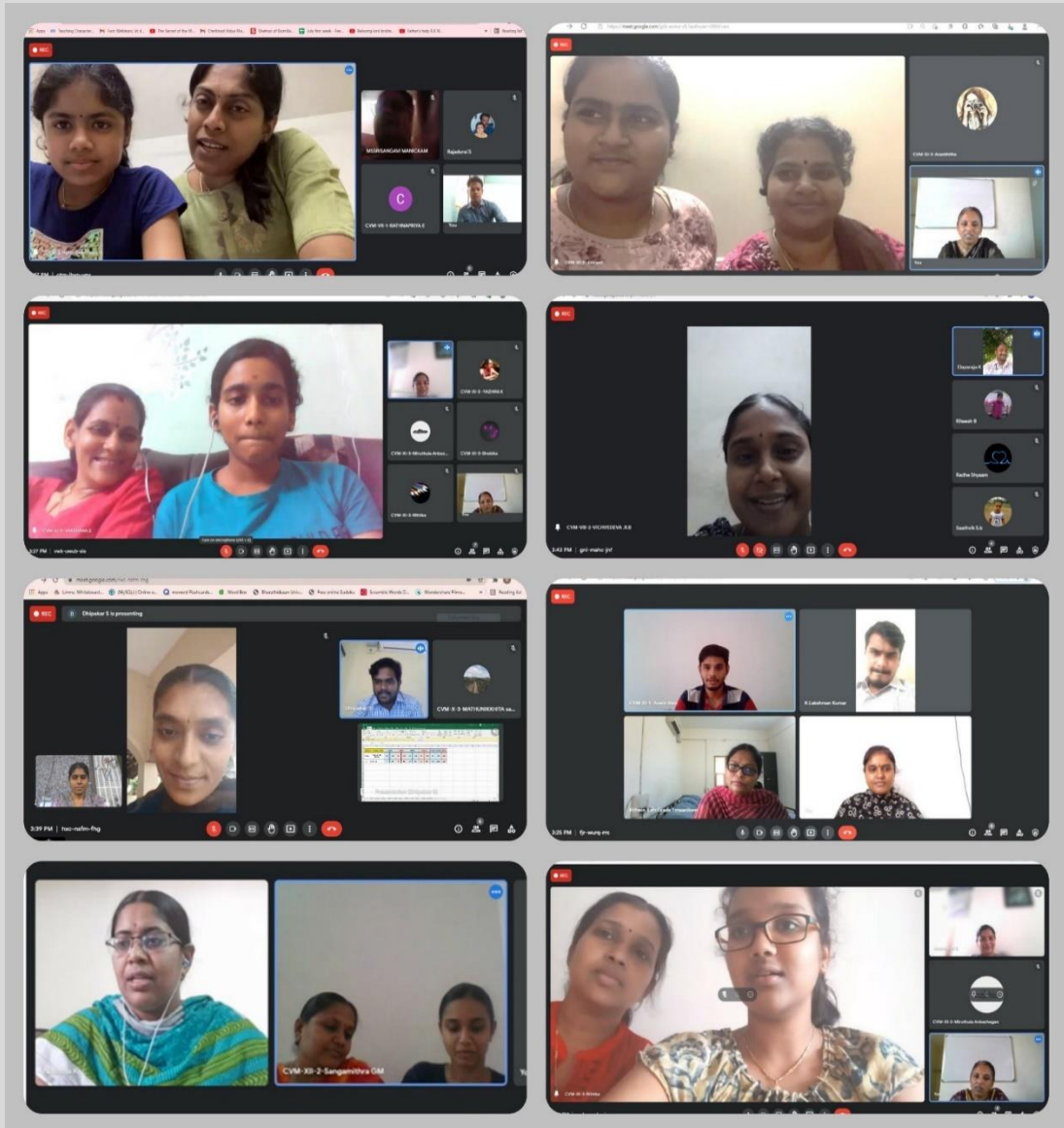

Parents Teachers Meet

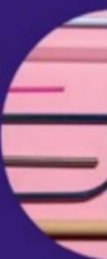

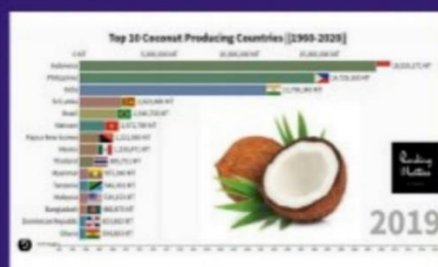

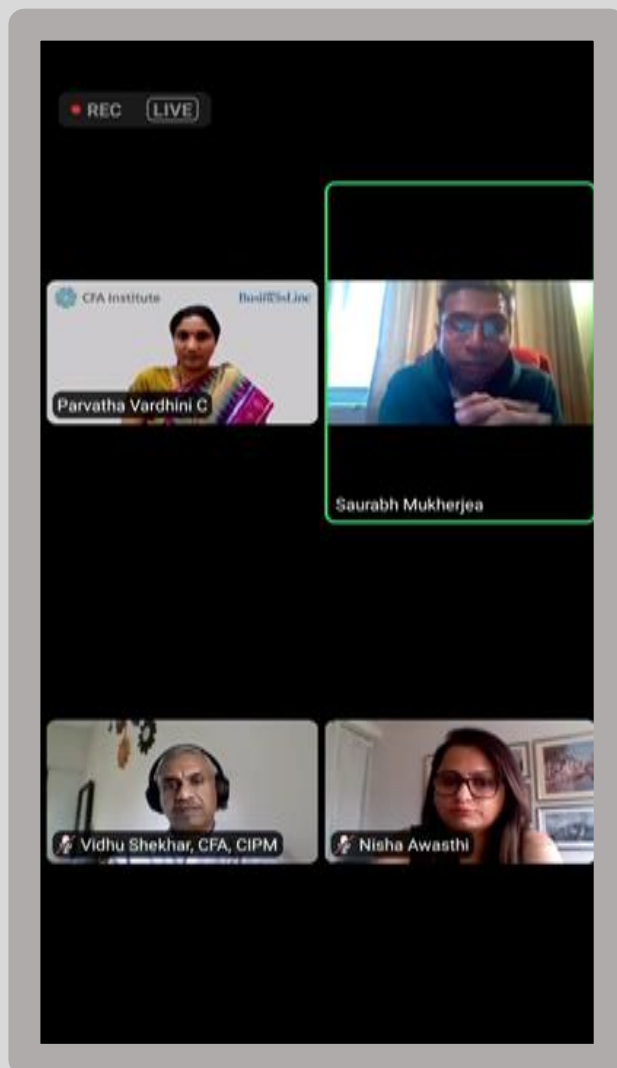
Problem:

CFA Session



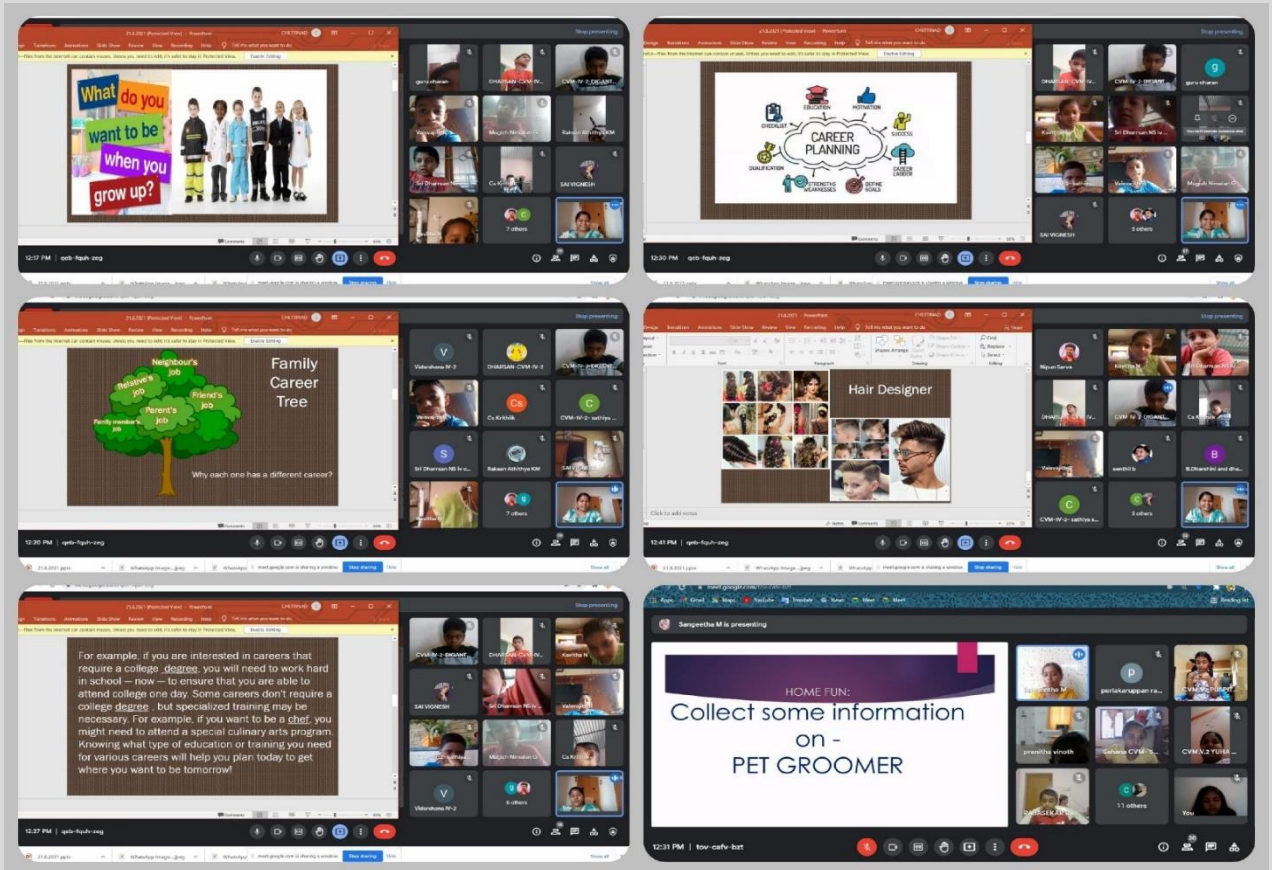

LIM Session for Parents



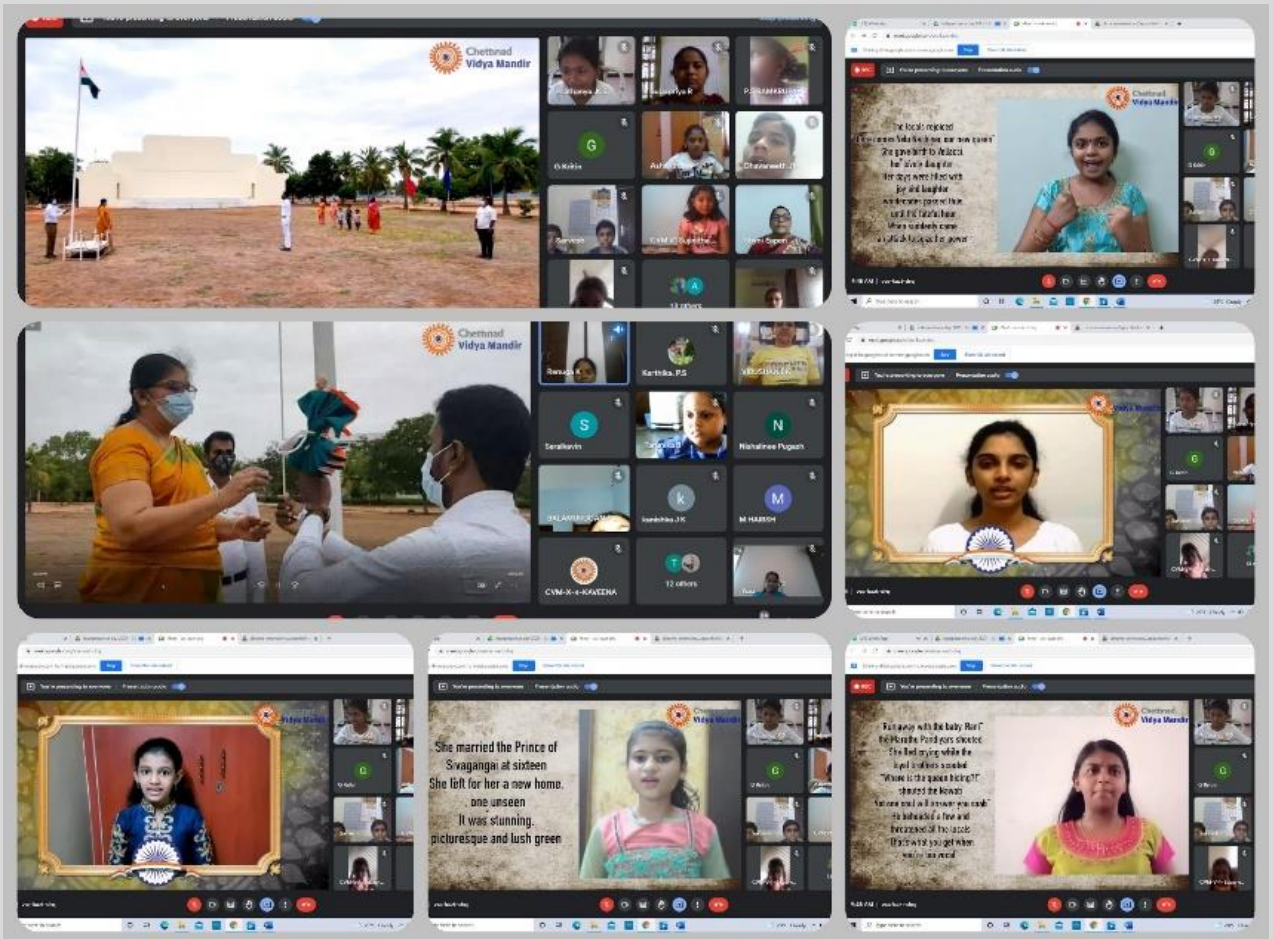

Career Exploration

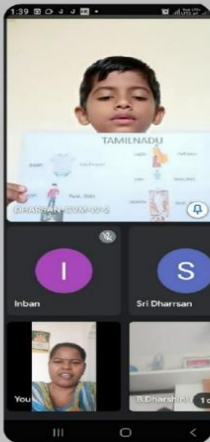
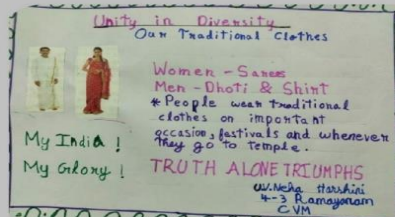

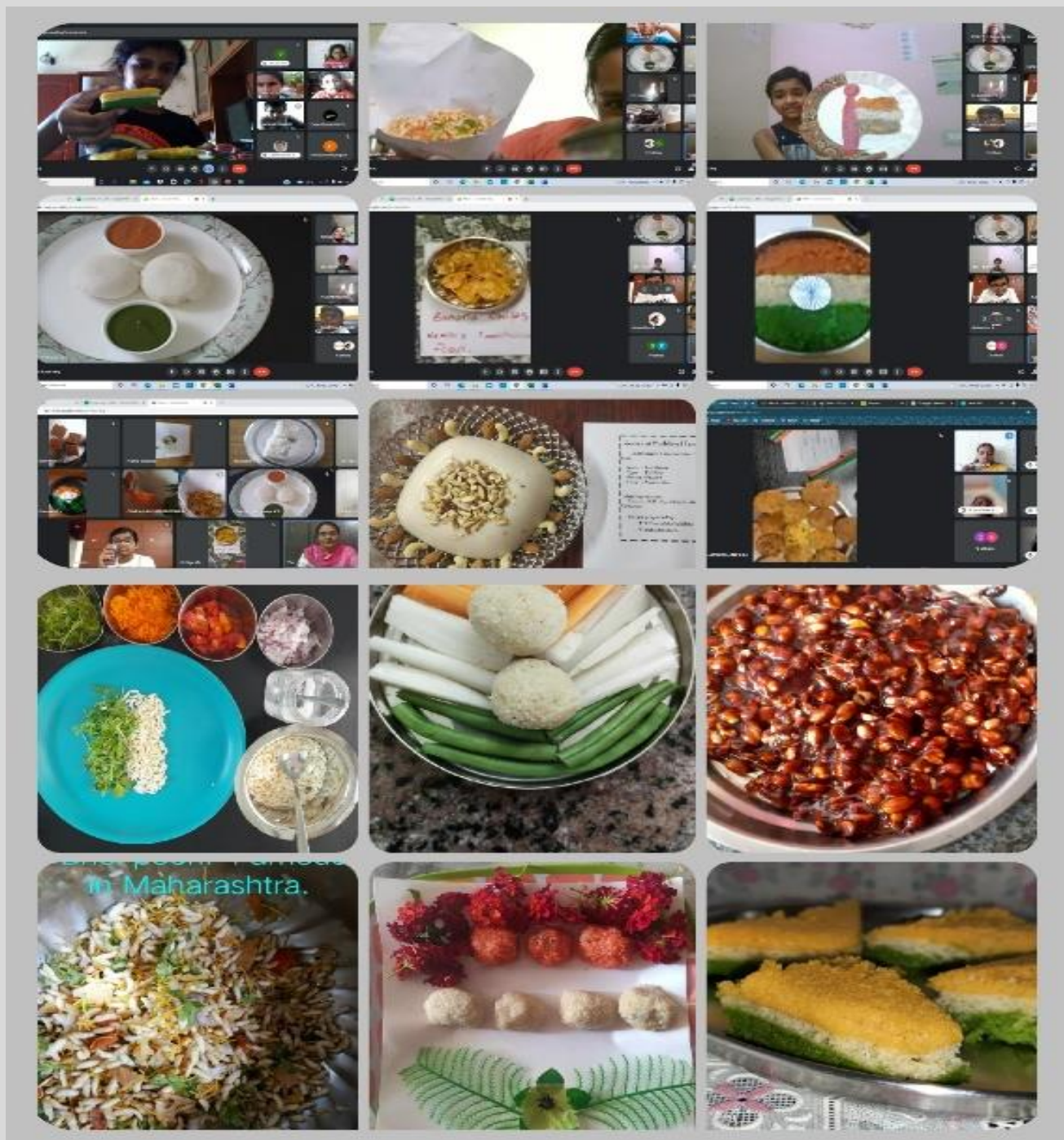
Independence Day

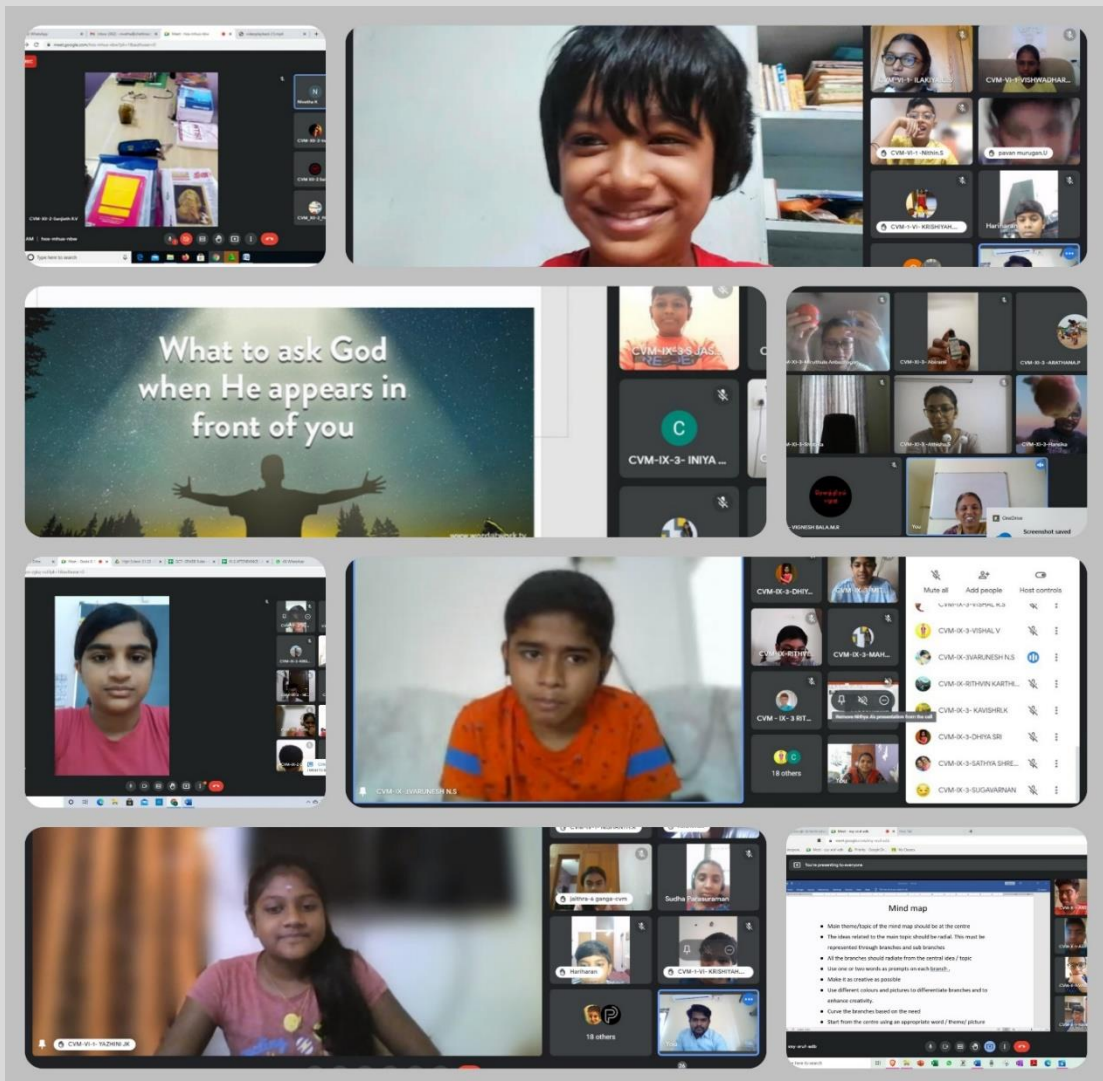
Thanks Giving Day

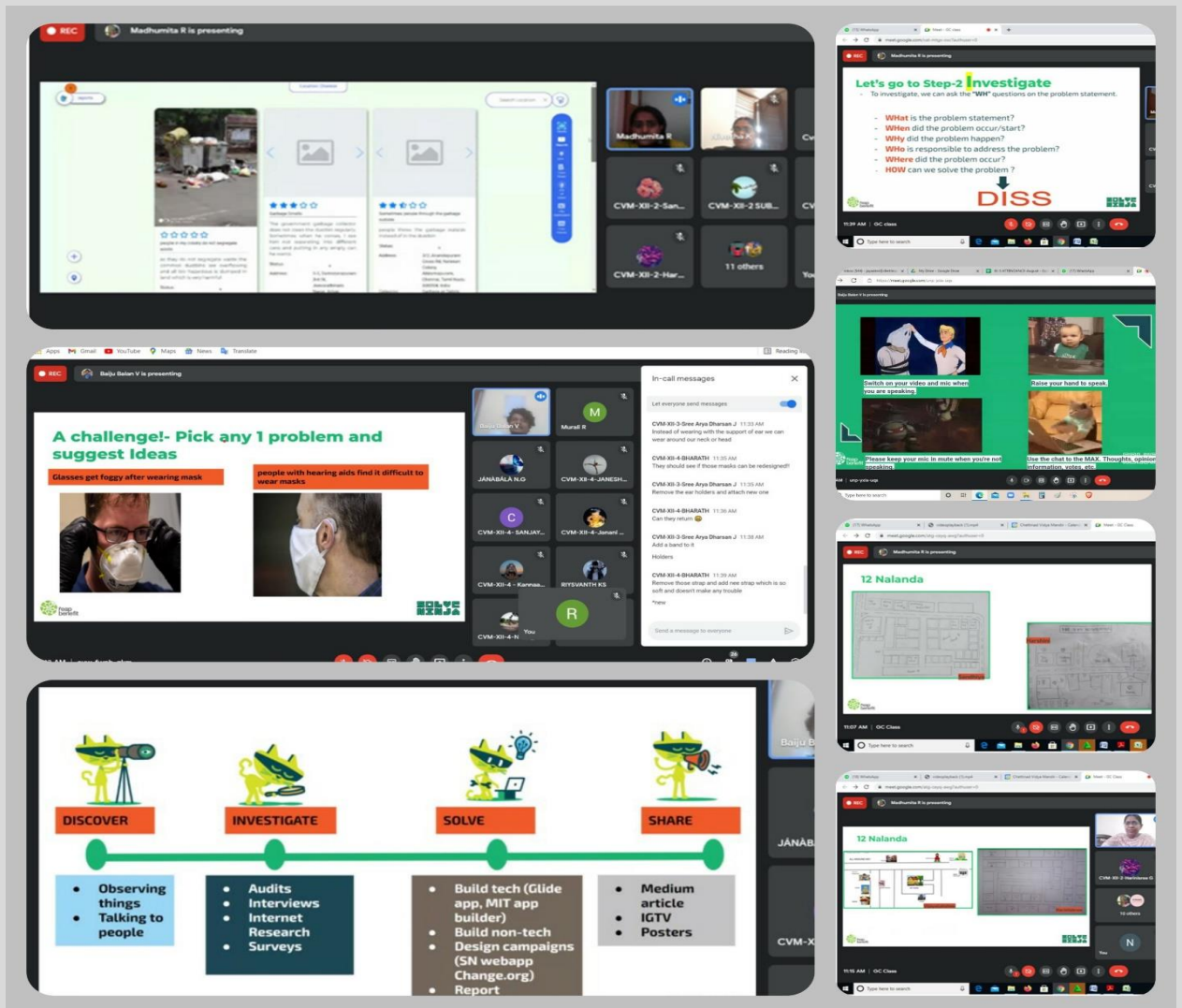


Quality Circle Time



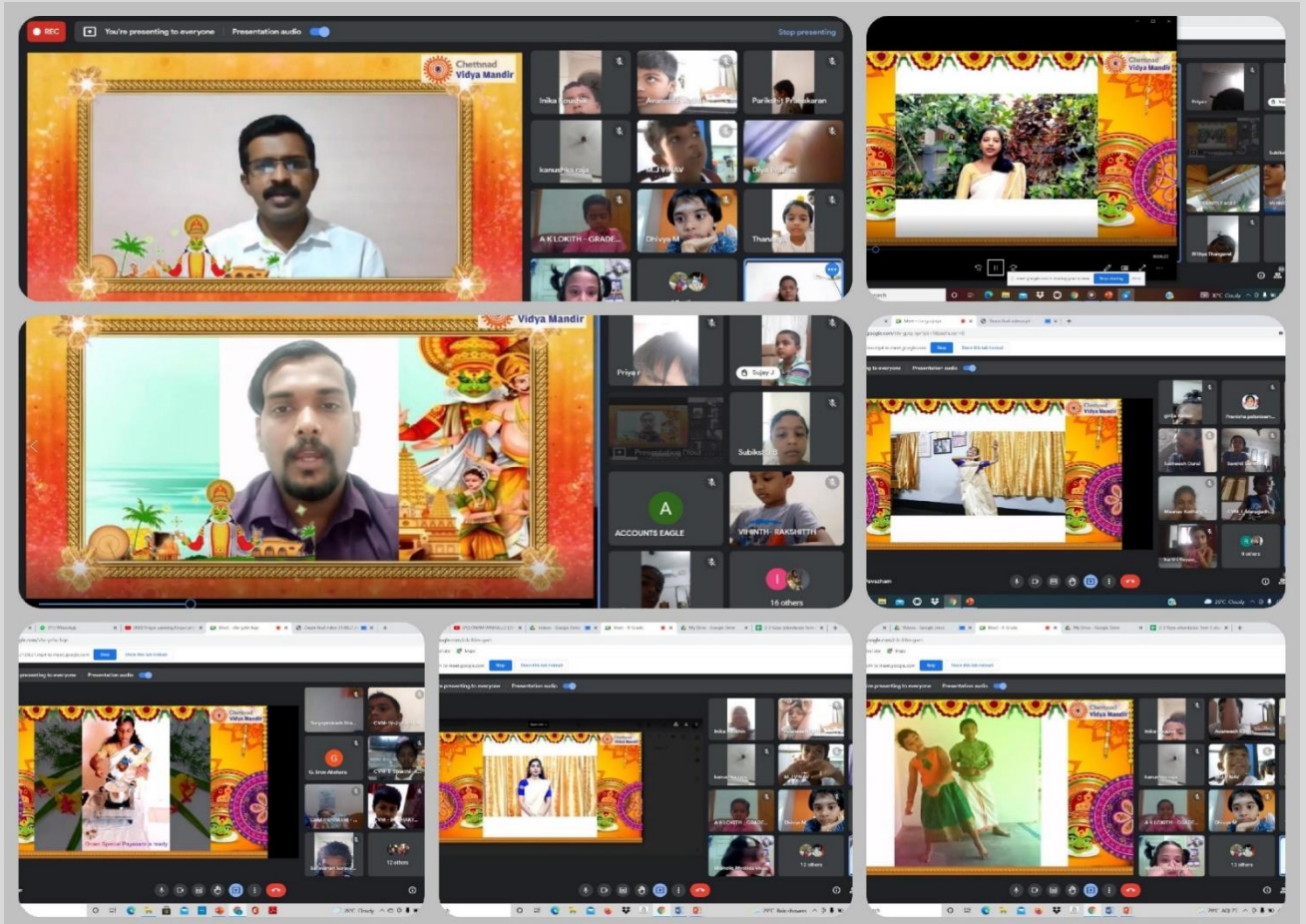

Global Citizenship

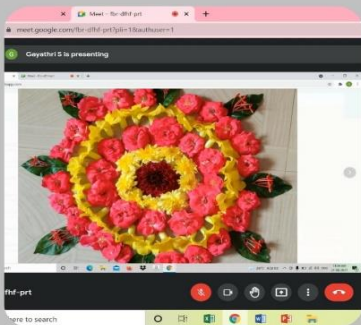

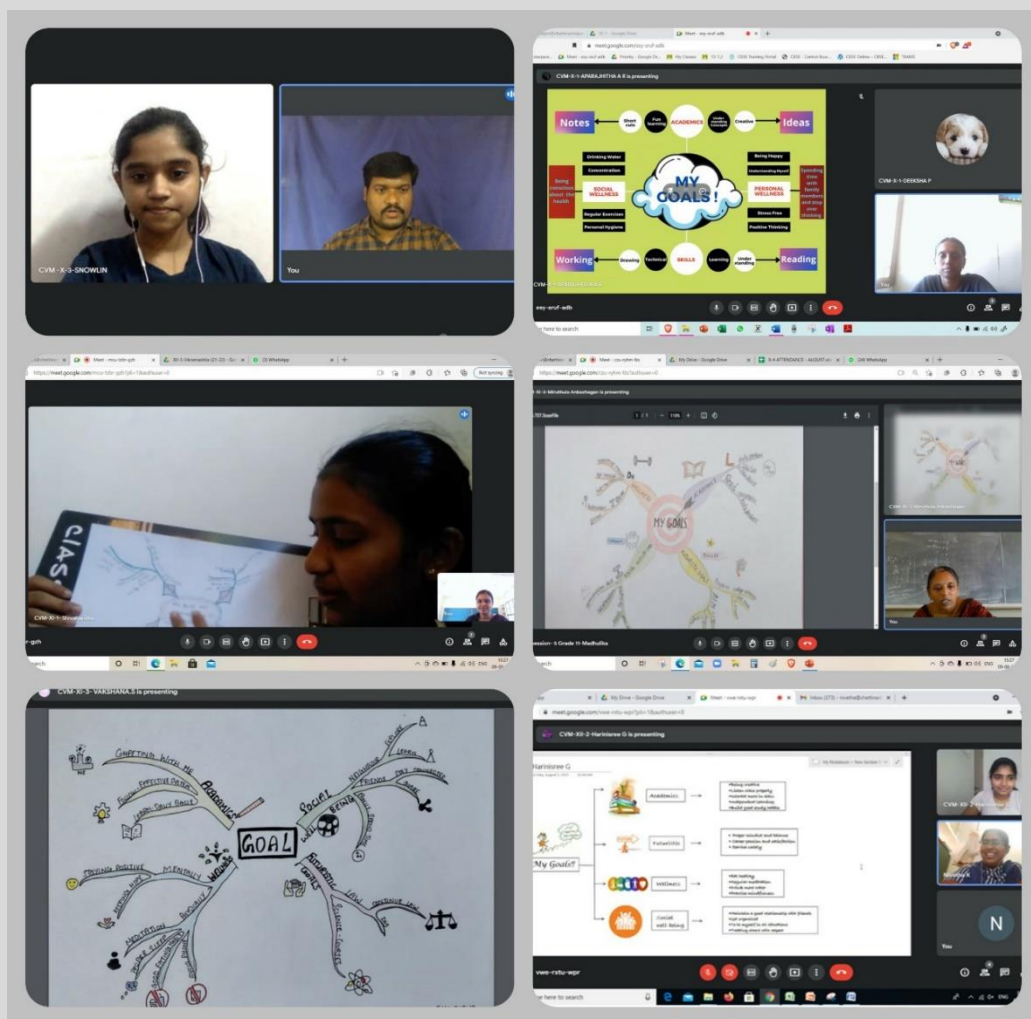
Onam Celebration

Science Week

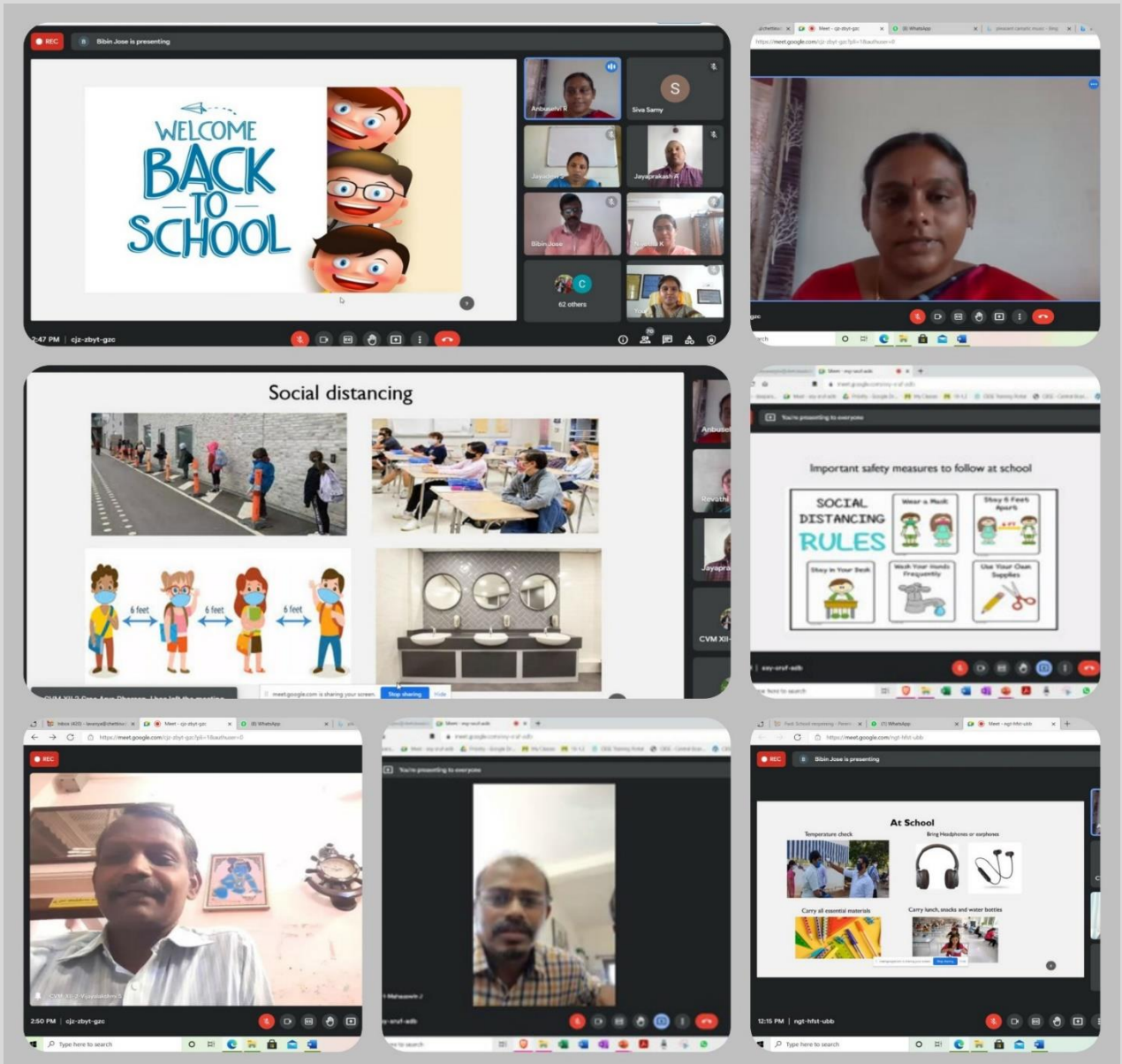

Parent Orientation



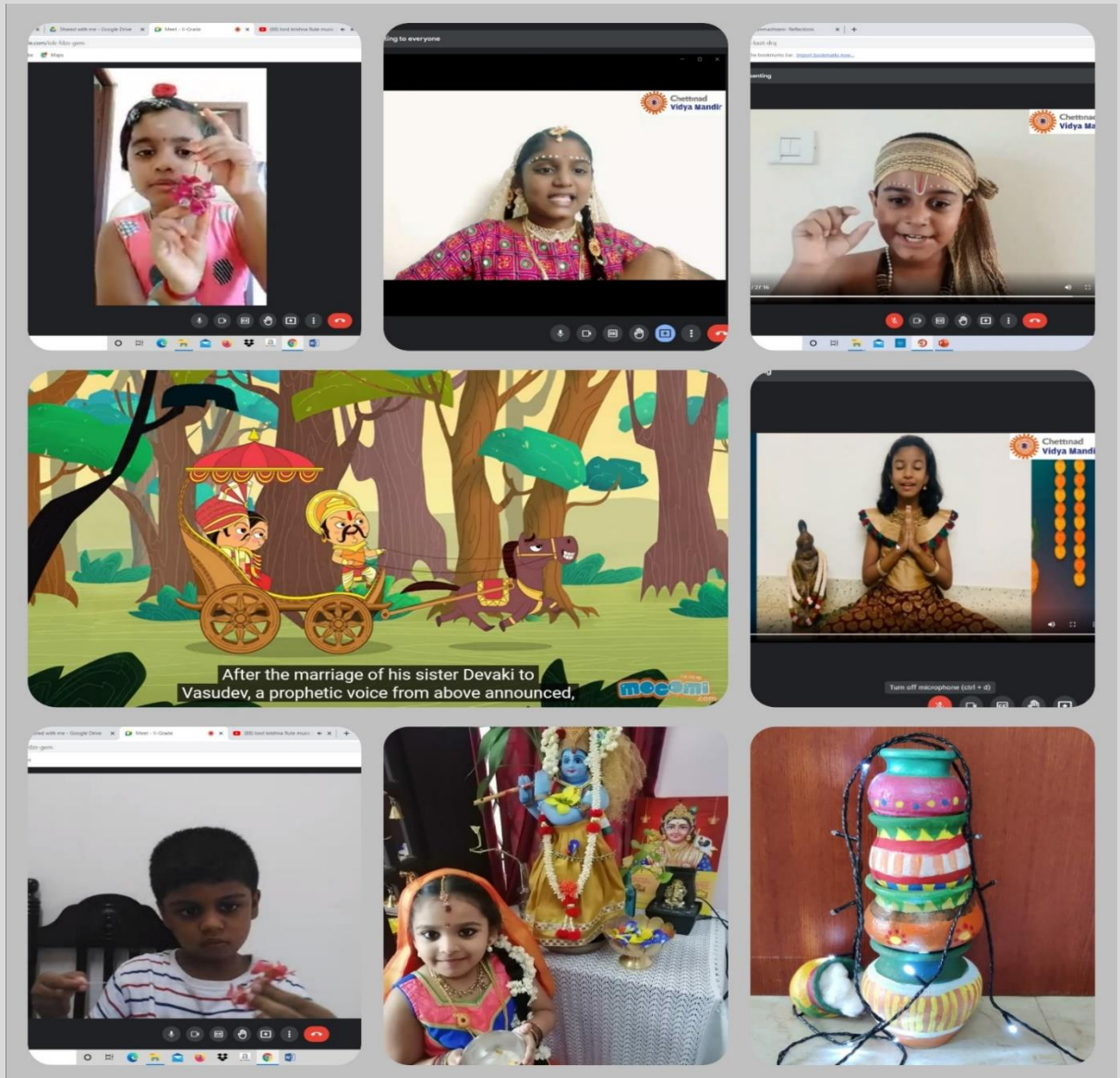
The Parent Orientation regarding the reopening of school was organized to enlighten parents about the safety guidelines and protocols.

Webifair Events



Denial-of-Service (DoS) Attack


an intentional attempt to prevent legitimate users from accessing a service or network by flooding the target with traffic, overwhelming the target and preventing legitimate users from accessing the service.

This network is capable of flooding the target site with enough traffic to overwhelm the target server, preventing legitimate users from accessing the service.

The Mysterious Tale of a Ransomware Cartel



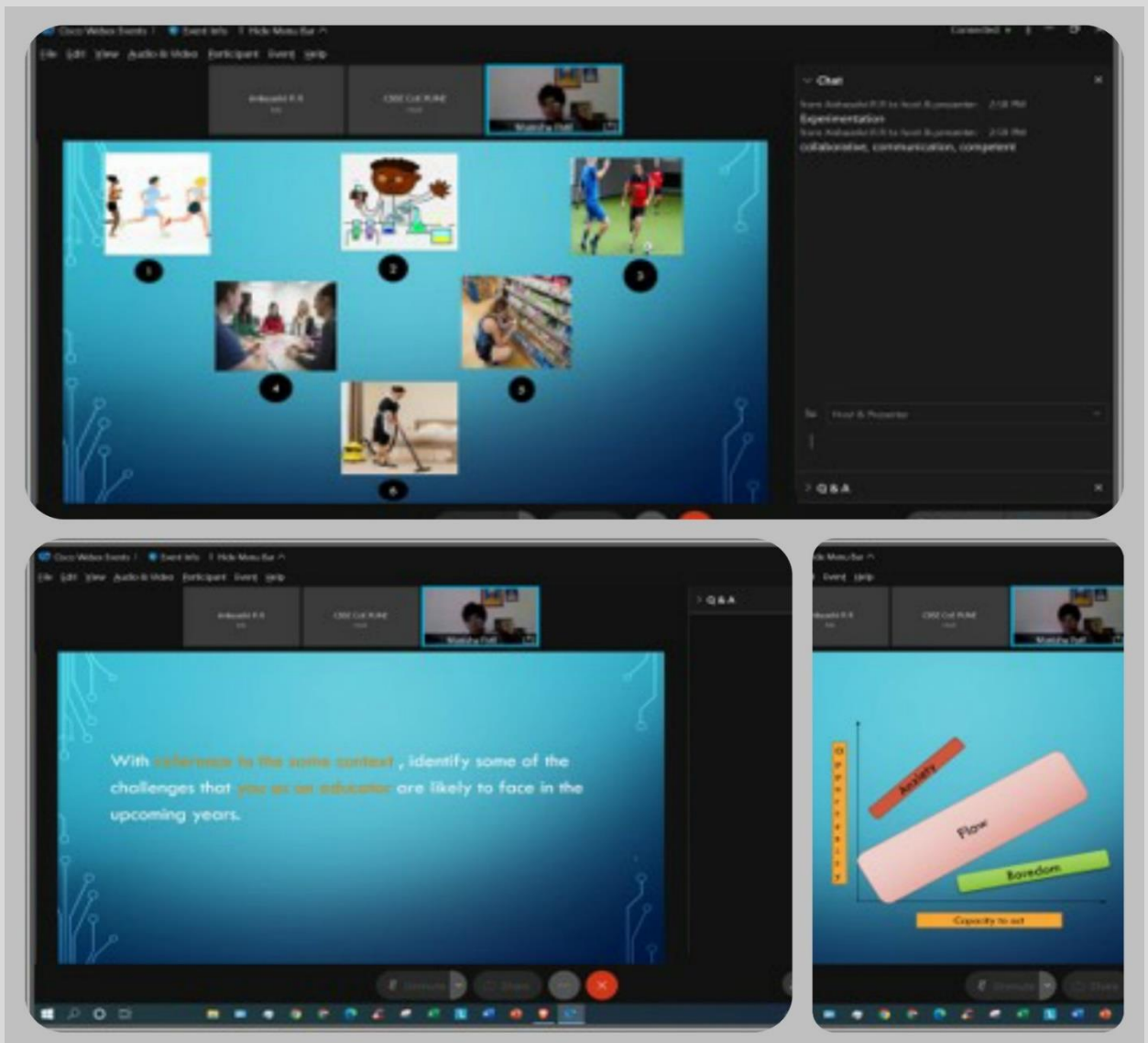
Analysis suggests that four different ransomware groups formed a cartel to leak stolen data via their partners. What surprised the researchers most is the missing element of profit sharing.

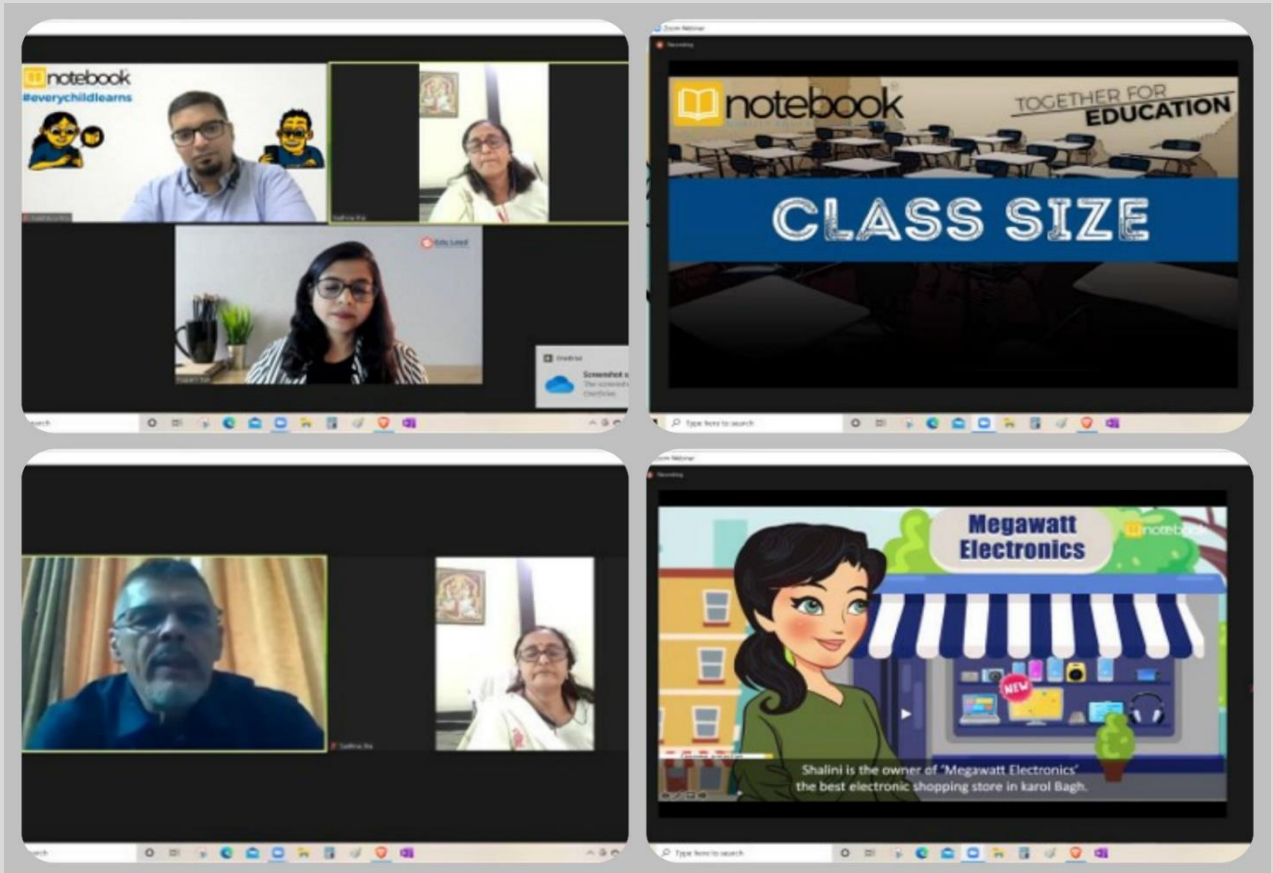

Anger Free Schools
