

Navaratri Celebration

























Parent Orientation




Parents were oriented about the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and the safety measures implemented by the school before the school reopened physically, after a long time.

Parent Teacher Meeting





APER - A Storytelling Workshop





Gandhi Jayanthi





Global Citizenship - Project on Covid





Quality Circle Time (QCT)





Utsav - A Preparatory Session




